



## POST TREATMENT CLEANING PROTOCOL clinic based

- Post treatment, remove visor by sink area, wipe over immediately with clinell wipes and then immediately wash hands to elbow.
- Leave room and allow patient to dress  
Once patient has departed :
- If the windows are not already open, door and window to be opened for full ventilation of clinic room
- Mask can be removed once patient has left and disposed of into lidded waste
- If not already worn, gloves to be donned for cleaning
- Couch carefully stripped of linen, following guidelines for removal of beds with minimal disruption to material. Folding to middle to slowly gather up and then dispose of into lidded, lined, wash bin.
- Couch surface to be thoroughly cleaned down with required spray and wipes, with attention to face hole area. Plastic covered pillow to be wiped down.
- Sufficient time allowed for drying and effectiveness of cleaning produce as per manufacturing guidelines



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- Whilst couch airs, cleaning down of all touched areas / patients lidded belongings box, massage medium bottles, all handles / desks / chairs/ taps / sinks / door and all surfaces touched within treatment room and also those areas encountered by patient on their journey from entrance to treatment couch and back to exit.
- Soiled PPE to be removed according to recommendations, placed in sealed bin.
- Hands washed to elbows
- Fresh PPE put on. If changing top change now (taking care with removal over head) if not changing top, to don fresh apron as per of the new PPE
- Fresh linen placed on couch for arrival of new client. Removed from the clean linen lidded storage box. Bottom sheet / towel for head support / top sheet / couch roll over cleaned plastic covered pillow and over face towels for added comfort and protection.
- Windows doors to be closed (unless suitable to leave window open for ventilation)
- Be ready to greet next patient into treatment room



## **POST TREATMENT CLEANING PROTOCOL clinic based**

- Welcome patient into room, supply hand gel or show where sink is for hand washing, explain protocol
- Once patient is on the couch, wash hands to elbow before making any hands-on contact, and again to wash hands if come into contact with any surface other than cleaned massage medium pot.
