

POST TREATMENT CLEANING

PROTOCOL mobile visits

- Post treatment, allow patient to get up and dress in privacy , leave to go and wash hands in most appropriate sink, away from other family members, touching nothing en route and using feet/elbows to open doors etc., where possible.
- Do not use family towels to dry hands, access own couch roll and dispose of in waste bag.
- Return to treatment space once client vacated, and prepare for clean-up process;
- If not already on, Don gloves for clean up
- Remove visor, wipe over immediately with clinell wipes
- If the windows are not already open, request if ok to ventilate space
- Couch carefully stripped of linen, following guidelines for removal of beds with minimal disruption to material. Folding corners to middle to slowly gather up and then dispose of all linen into wash bag ready for removal.
- Couch surface to be thoroughly cleaned down with required spray and wipes, with attention to face hole area. Plastic covered pillow to be wiped down.
- Couch roll and used cleaning wipes to be placed in plastic waste bag for removal. Any soiled PPE to be placed in this same waste bag for disposal also once finished with.

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- Whilst couch airs, cleaning down of any areas touched within clients home, including tap/sink/doors when washing hands.
- Soiled PPE to be removed according to recommendations, placed in sealed bin away from clients home.
- Pack up couch and belongings
- Hands washed to elbows, using disposal cloth to dry.
- Exit the home with minimal contact with other household members and limited contact with surfaces.
- Follow up and appointment setting to happen via phone after appointment
- If making another home visit, return home to change clothing / clean over couch cover and box of items. Collect new set of fresh linen and next patient's notes etc.
- Then set off to next appointment carrying only linen, equipment and notes needed for that individual visit.
